YOUR LEGISLATORS' VOTING RECORD ON SMALL BUSINESS ISSUES

2007–2008 SESSION: Roll call votes by state legislators on those issues where NFIB had an official position, and where a bill memorandum was used to alert lawmakers that the issue was important to small business, are listed below. The *Voting Record* is only one measure of a legislator's performance. A vote tally does not indicate which legislators represented small business interests in committees or behind the scenes. However, the record does indicate their positions when asked to vote on key issues on the floor of the House or the Senate. Please take the time to thank those legislators who supported legislation important to small business.

- A.9245: Creates a new paid family leave benefit under the state's temporary disability insurance program, giving employees up to 12 weeks of paid family leave, regardless of the size of their employer. A "No" vote supports the NFIB position. Passed the Assembly 105–21; no Senate vote.
- S.6385A/A.395A: Increases small business access to affordable, basic health insurance coverage through the Healthy-NY program by repealing the program's "crowd out" provision, which required that a business or individual be without health insurance coverage for a period of 12 months before being eligible for Healthy-NY. A "Yes" vote supports the NFIB position. Passed Senate 62–0; passed Assembly 134–7.
- S.7550/A.10656: Protects small businesses against exorbitant future increases in health insurance by capping the premium rate for individual proprietors who purchase health coverage through associations at 115 percent of the group premium. A "Yes" vote supports the NFIB position. Passed Senate 61–0; passed Assembly 140–0.

- S.5953A: Enacts the Senate's

 "Upstate-NOW" economic development program, a broad-based package of tax cuts, tax credits and economic development tools. These include health insurance and energy tax credits, reduced corporate tax rates, and elimination of the income and corporate franchise taxes on manufacturers.

 A "Yes" vote supports the NFIB position.

 Passed Senate 54–3; no Assembly vote.
- 5. S.3322/A.6163: Enacts significant reform to New York's workers' compensation system, including capping permanent partial disability. Legislation reduces costs for employers while also increasing the benefit rate for injured workers. A "Yes" vote supports the NFIB position. Passed Senate 61–0; passed Assembly 145–0.
- S.4364A/A.7438A: Creates a new and highly subjective cause of action entitled "light trespass" that would subject law-abiding small business owners to frivolous, expensive and harassing new lawsuits, despite the existence of adequate recourse for a person who feels the outdoor lights at a small business are misdirected or excessive. A "No" vote supports the NFIB position.

Passed Assembly 111-32; no Senate vote.

- A.408: Exposes small business owners to additional and open-ended lawsuits by employees who allege discrimination with respect to jury duty, despite existing law that secures an employee's right to be absent from employment for jury duty without fear of discharge or penalty. A "No" vote supports the NFIB position. Passed Assembly 137–4; no Senate vote.
- S.3936/A.2712: Enacts the "New York State Fair Pay Act," which includes redundant protections against discrimination for workers that would result in higher costs for businesses and more frivolous lawsuits. A "No" vote supports the NFIB position. Passed Assembly 113–30; no Senate vote.
- S.7594B: Suspends state taxes on gasoline and other motor fuels from Memorial Day weekend to Labor Day weekend, which would provide savings of approximately 30 cents per gallon of fuel.

 A "Yes" vote supports the NFIB position.

 Passed Senate 46–15; no Assembly vote.
- 10. S.314/A.732: Requires state agenumary of the key legislative, budgetary and regulatory changes that affect small businesses each year. A "Yes" vote supports the NFIB position. Passed Senate 61–0; passed Assembly 140–0.
- \$1.258A/A.718: Requires state agencies that promulgate rules and regulations that affect small businesses to post guides on their Web site to assist

small businesses in complying with the rule or regulation. A "Yes" vote supports the NFIB position. Passed Senate, 61–0; passed Assembly 149–0.

12. S.4736: Proposes amendment of the New York State constitution to limit the governor, comptroller and attorney general to two elective terms. A "Yes" vote supports the NFIB position. Passed Senate 36–22; no Assembly vote.

 $13_{\bullet}^{\text{S.4737: Limits the temporary}}$ president of the Senate, speaker of

the Assembly, and minority leaders of the Senate and Assembly to eight years in their posts. Committee chairs would be limited to six years. These provisions would not apply retroactively or limit the number of terms a legislator could serve in office. A "Yes" vote supports the NFIB position. Passed Senate 56–2; no Assembly vote.

14. S.5850A/A.8044A: Greatly expands the number and type of bottles returnable to small retailers and would require businesses to remit unclaimed deposits to the state. A "No"

vote supports the NFIB position. Passed Assembly 91–54; no Senate vote.
